

The .45-70 Government (left) got its name from the .45-caliber bullet with a cartridge case holding 70 grains of black powder adopted by the U.S. Military in the 1870s. The .45-90 (center) held 90 grains of black powder and the buffalo hunter's favorite, the .45-120 (right) held a whopping 120 grains of powder.



The front sight of the High-Wall Sporting model is dovetailed into the octagonal barrel and can be drifted for windage.
