In spite of his young age, William “Billy the Kid” Bonney was one of the most notorious gunfighters in the Wild West, his life ending in 1881 at the receiving end of Sheriff Pat Garrett’s .44. 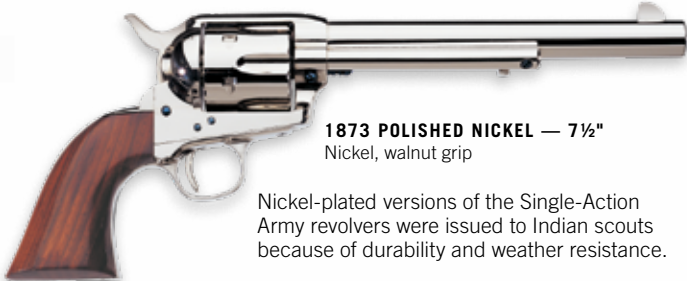

Uberti's 1866 "Yellowboy" Rifle was the first true Cowboy lever-action widely carried in a saddle scabbard. It incorporates improvements made to the original Henry Rifle, including a side loading gate, making the new rifle more functional and allowing the addition of a fore-end.

Uberti's 1866 Yellowboy lever-action rifle features a side loading gate—one of the major improvements over the 1860 Henry.



Another improvement is the addition of a satin walnut fore-end, which is embellished with a brass fore-end cap.

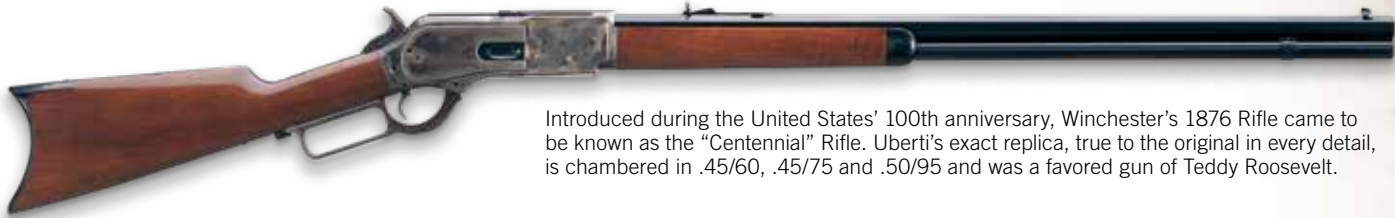

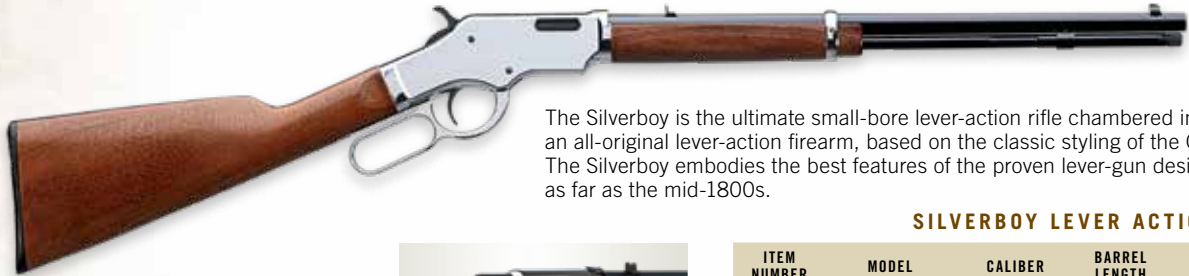
